NOTICE OF RACE FOR (some) PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS (See para. 1)

1. This Notice of Race shall apply to the 2008 Munster, Ulster and Connaught Championships (including the Ladies and Masters Championships but **NOT** the National Championships). It shall be read in conjunction with the individual event details printed above and those details shall form part of this Notice.
2. The Organising Authority is the appropriate host Club in conjunction with the Irish Laser Association.
3. Racing shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association
4. Lasers using the Standard, Radial or 4.7 Rig are entitled to compete (except that the Ladies C'ship will be sailed in Radial Rigs only and the Masters Championship will be sailed in Standard Rigs only).
5. Boats shall use their correct sail numbers in accordance with the ILCA Rules and RRS Appendix G.
6. Entry may be made on the form (downloadable from the Class website) and a discount is applicable if the completed form and full payment is posted to the Hon. Secretary (Ron Hutchieson) at least eight days prior to the first event that they are attending. Entry forms posted after that date will not be eligible for the discount and if a form is not available during registration the sailor will be requested to complete a new form and make new payment. (If the original form subsequently materialises a refund will be made.) Entries may be accepted during the event (no discount applicable) but only to a predetermined maximum number of boats. This number depends on the number of boats pre-entered as well as the current and expected wind and weather conditions.
7. Registration will commence at 09.00 hrs. on Saturday and a briefing will be held at the time stated in the details above.
8. In accordance with the Rules of the ILCA, all competitors shall be members of the Irish Laser Assoc. or another Laser District Association (proof required). Facilities for joining will be available at registration.
9. Those competitors who have pre-entered **AND** have paid their Laser subscription for the year are entitled to register ahead of anyone who requires to complete forms or pay money and should make themselves known so that they receive preferential treatment.
NEW - They will also be given the opportunity to register on Friday evening at a time and place which will be posted on the ILA website prior to the respective event. As they have all pre-entered the registration process will normally only take a few seconds.
10. Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
11. The courses will normally be trapezoid but triangles may be used under certain circumstances.
12. The first Warning Signal for the first race at each of the events will be made at 11.25 hrs. on the first day of the event and 3 races per day are scheduled (6 races total). If only three races are sailed all shall be counted.
